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10 DAYS UGANDA – RWANDA SAFARI

DAY 1: Arrival at Entebbe Airport via Mabamba swamp for shoebill and Transfer to Mbale



Upon arrival at the airport you will be picked up by our company driver/guide who will shortly brief you about our 14 Days Uganda safari. After, we shall go for shoebills at Mabamba swamp.

Then transfer to Mbale where you will head to the hotel for Accommodation. **Wash and Will Hotel**

DAY 2: Sipi Hike and Transfer to Jinja

After breakfast you will visit the waterfalls. Sipi falls is comprised of 3 levels of waterfalls, 100m being the highest, 85 m, second highest and 75m being the lowest. Depending on your physical fitness and time available, you will decide on whether to visit all the levels or two or one of them. Hiking to the falls mainly take 3 hours, with great views of the communities and plantations. After start



Abseiling on the top of the falls which is definitely another activity

Standing on the top of the highest Sipi waterfall you will get a short briefing about the abseiling. You will put your abseiling gear on and get to the edge of the drop-off.

This is when the adrenaline kicks in.

Slowly hang your body off the cliff and start with the slow descent to the bottom of the waterfall. You will have time to enjoy the amazing view and have a mind-blowing experience. Then transfer to Jinja Accommodation. Nile Village Hotel

DAY 3: Rafting on the Nile



After breakfast we go for the most interesting rafting in the upper White Nile. Rafting in Jinja is pretending to be the best in the world. Widely regarded as the best one day rafting trip on the planet.

DAY 4: Arrival & Transfer to Rhinos at Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary then proceed to Murchison Falls National Park.



After breakfast at the hotel, you will be transferred to Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary Located in Nakasongola District for Rhino Trekking. Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary is the only place in Uganda that has rhinos, making it a must visit for those who want to see the big five in Uganda (lion, leopard, elephant, rhino, buffalo).

Later on you will be driven to Murchison Falls National Park through the Top of Murchison Falls.

Accommodation: Pakuba Safari Lodge

DAY 5: Game drive, then boat trip at Murchison Falls National Park



After breakfast, enjoy an early morning game drive on the northern part of the National park where you will see with different animal species that include four of the big 5 that is the Lions, leopard, elephants and buffaloes. Other animals you will encounter are the Rothschild's giraffe, warthogs, antelopes and birds. After lunch, you will head out for cruise where you will see hippos, Nile crocodiles as well as different bird species, some of the 76 species of mammals found in this National Park. The boat Cruise usually take up to 3 hours. Then you will head back to the hotel in Masindi for relaxation, dinner and overnight.

DAY 6: Morning Chimpanzee trekking then transfer to Queen Elizabeth National Park For Evening Boat Cruise



After breakfast, head off for briefing that will takesome minutes prior to your activity.

Thirteen species can be sought, and a good variety of diurnal monkeys invariably encountered, but the stars of this trail are the chimpanzees. Kanyanchu's chimps have been tracked since 1993 and the chances of locating them are excellent. Guided walks start, depending on various factors.

This is also an amazing activity for bird watchers because Budongo Forest is blessed with a wide variety of different bird species as you do your habituation the chimpanzees, chances are you will get to see different bird species then transfer to Queen Elizabeth National Park for evening Boat cruise.

DAY 7: Game drive in Kasenyi & Ishasha Sector then Transfer To Bwindi



Early breakfast, then have a morning game drive in Kasenyi to spot the lions, buffaloes, elephants, antelopes, warthogs, waterbuck, hyena, topis, leopards, hippos, among others.



Then Ishasha tree- climbing Lions and other animals. Enjoy a safari game drive in Ishasha where the king of the jungle lions is often spotted lying on Acadia tree branches as they quietly wait for the food or prey inform of antelopes. Then transfer to Bwindi National Park where you will get there in the evening hours.

DAY 8: Tracking Gorillas in Bwindi and Transfer to Rwanda



After your breakfast you will carry your packed lunch head a briefing about gorilla trekking. You will be allowed to spend one hour with them in their natural habitat taking photos, recording the moments and learning more about their lifestyle, behaviors habits and there close relation to Human beings. Grouping of individuals at the park headquarters is done according to age, personal preferences and physical fitness therefore visitors who are not physically fit are advised to communicate early before the booking of the gorilla permit so that they allocate you a gorilla family that is easy to trek. Then transfer to Rwanda where you'll arrive in the evening hours.

DAY 9: Trekking Golden monkeys in Rwanda & Transfer to Lake Kivu



After breakfast begin the golden monkey trekking in Rwanda which mostly takes place in the found in the Virunga Mountains. Trek for 2 – 4 hours while searching for these rare species of primates.

Spend one hour with these primates once seen. Transfer to Lake Kivu.

Accommodation: Paradis Malahide

DAY 10: Boat cruise on Lake Kivu and Transfer back to Kigali vist Genocide Memorial

After breakfast, enjoy a relaxing boat cruise and community tour on Lake Kivu. You can also see Nyiragongo volcanoes while doing the boat cruise. Then afterwards you'll transfer to Kigali.



Visit the genocide memorial, local large markets and different craft centres. You'll be dropped off at the airport for your departure.
