<u>DAY 1: Arrival at Entebbe Airport via Mabamba swamp and Botanical Garderns</u> <u>for shoebill trekking</u>





Amboseli National Park is situated in south of Nairobi, Most of the park consist of a dry ,ancient lake bed and fragile grassland with patches of acacia woodland, while in the southern area there is a number of small ,rocky, volcanic hills. Around the swamps Ol Okenya, Ol Tukai and Enkongo Narok, the vegetation is lush with yellow barked acacias and phoenix palms in National Park.


