DAY 1: Arrival at Entebbe Airport via Mabamba swamp and Botanical Gardens for shoebill trekking

DAY 2: Transfer to Bwindi Via Equator



After an early morning breakfast and then you will start the journey to the Bwindi National Park. On your way you will pass via equator for photos, and experience an effect that objects with the part nearer to the equator, deflect further and faster than the part nearest to the equator the south and the north pole then after crossing From North to south proceed through Mbarara to Kabale to Bwindi national

DAY 3: Tracking Gorillas in Bwindi



After your breakfast you will carry your packed lunch head a briefing about gorilla trekking. You will be allowed to spend one hour with them in their natural habitat taking photos, recording the moments and learning more about their lifestyle, behaviors habits and there close relation to Human beings. Grouping of individuals at the park headquarters is done according to age, personal preferences and physical fitness therefore visitors who are not physically fit are advised to communicate

early before the booking of the gorilla permit so that they allocate you a gorilla family that is easy to trek. Then Transfer to Ishasha

DAY 4: Game drive in Ishasha Sector & Kasenye Queen Elizabeth National Park



Early breakfast, then have a morning game drive in Ishasha sector to search for the tree-climbing Lions and other animals. Enjoy a safari game drive in Ishasha where the king of the jungle lions is often spotted lying on Acacia tree branches as they quietly wait for the food or prey in form of antelopes. Then game drive in Kasenye to spot the lions, buffaloes, elephants, antelopes, warthogs, waterbuck, hyena, topis, leopards, hippos, among others. Then proceed to Semuliki national Park Fortportal.

DAY 5: Transfer to Murchison Falls NP for Evening Boat cruise



Then after transfer to Murchison Falls NP for an evening boat cruise and Top of falls, Then proceed through top of falls. And enjoy Murchison falls top of the falls hike is always a two in one activity for you get the best time watching the birds and also enjoy the spectacular view of the Nile and the landscape in Murchison falls national park.

DAY 6: Morning Game drive , Top of Falls and evening Chimpanzee trekking in Murchison falls National Park



Morning game drive in Murchison falls National Park on the northern part of the National park where you will see with different animal species that include four of the big 5 that is the Lions, leopard, elephants and buffaloes. Other animals you will encounter are the Rothschild's giraffe, warthogs, antelopes and birds etc. Then proceed for Top of Falls on the Nile where you will see different bird species, Roaring river in gauge found in this National Park.



Then proceed through top of falls. Murchison falls top of the falls hike is always a two in one activity for you get the best time watching the birds and also enjoy the spectacular view of the Nile and the landscape in Murchison falls national park. Then evening Chimpanzee trekking

Thirteen species can be sought, and a good variety of diurnal monkeys invariably encountered, but the stars of this trail are the chimpanzees that are the closest relatives to the human species found in this

Amboseli National Park is situated in south of Nairobi, Most of the park consist of a dry ,ancient lake bed and fragile grassland with patches of acacia woodland, while in the southern area there is a number of small ,rocky, volcanic hills. Around the swamps Ol Okenya, Ol Tukai and Enkongo Narok, the vegetation is lush with yellow barked acacias and phoenix palms in National Park.

After breakfast you will head out for Deep sea fishing experience also referred to as offshore fishing requires navigational charts, conducive weather, fishing gear and definitely overcoming water phobia. Once on the deep seas, fishing takes place at depths of at least 100ft (30m) – this is the only way you can catch game fish big enough to validate being in deep waters otherwise you'd just fish in shallow

shore waters and flirt with the small fish. Fishing for adventure is relatively safe compared to commercial fishing which in some cases goes as deep as 2000 metres with extremely very heavy trawls that are pulled across the seabed which unfortunately has its environmental setbacks. 30 meters will exhilarate you just as much as it will shock you, deep sea wonders are infinite and that probably explains why the little fish never sought to return to shallow waters, only God knows of her survival.
